**South Georgia State College students are classified as either in-state or out-of-state for tuition purposes. Students classified as in-state are assessed at the in-state tuition rate which is significantly lower than the out-of-state tuition rate. In general, independent students are classified as in-state or out-of-state based on their state of domicile and dependent students are classified based on the domicile of their parents(s) or U.S. court-appointed legal guardian.**

**Domicile is defined as a person’s present, permanent home where the individual intends to stay indefinitely and to which that individual returns following periods of temporary absence. Temporary residence does not constitute the establishment of one’s domicile.**

**Residency is defined as the state and country where an individual currently lives. An individual may be residing in Georgia without having established domicile in the state.**

**Tuition Classification Information: In accordance with Board of Regents Policy 4.3.4, all applicants who are accepted for admission or readmission to South Georgia State College for fall 2011 or any academic semester thereafter, and who seek to be classified as in-state for tuition purposes, will be required to provide validation of residency and lawful presence in both the State of Georgia and the United States.**
