

Number of Degrees Conferred by Fiscal Year

The College monitors degrees conferred as a measure of success of its undergraduate programs. SGSC has set its benchmark at FY2014 total degrees conferred and the target is to improve by an average of two percent each fiscal year for the next five years (overall 10 percent). Enrollment drops related to changes in learning support rules and financial aid policies led to a significant drop in enrollment after FY 2012, consequently impacting the number of degrees conferred at the college. The target has continued to be met for the last three fiscal years.




Exhibit 1: Number of Degrees Conferred by Fiscal Year
