

Freshmen Students

South Georgia State College currently has several Associate of Arts Degrees, Associate of Science Degrees, an Associate of Science in Nursing, a Bachelor of Science in Nursing, as well as a Bachelor of Science in Biological Sciences and Management.

Requirements:

- Application for enrollment.
- One-time \$20.00 enrollment fee.
- Official high school transcripts with graduation date or official GED scores.
- Official College Transcripts (if applicable).
- An immunization record, completed by a health care professional.
- Lawful Presence.
- AccuPlacer and/or Compass Test scores.*

* AccuPlacer and/or COMPASS Test: The AccuPlacer Test and/or the COMPASS test can be exempted if the following requirements are met: SAT scores of 430 English, 400 math (Old SAT), Reading 24 and Math 22 (New SAT), or ACT scores of 17 English, 17 math. The AccuPlacer Test and/or the COMPASS test is used for entrance and placement purposes to determine whether learning support classes are needed.

The Compass Test is no longer being offered; however, we will continue to accept Compass Scores. The new placement exam is AccuPlacer.

College coursework: Students who transfer less than 30 hours of college or technical school coursework into SGSC will be classified as freshmen. In this case, SGSC requires all college or technical school transcripts to be mailed from the institution attended. Students transferring more than 30 hours of coursework will be a classified as transfer students.
