

Military Students

At South Georgia State College, we honor and appreciate the men and women of our armed services. South Georgia State College is approved for the educational training of veterans and certain eligible spouses and dependents of veterans. The institution serves only as a source of certification and information to the Veterans Administration as all financial transactions and eligibility determinations are handled directly between the student and the VA. Veterans and other eligible persons interested in obtaining educational benefits must meet all applicable requirements for admissions. Any questions regarding the eligibility of a veteran or dependent can be answered by calling the Department of Veterans Affairs at 1-888-GIBILL1.

Requirements:

- Application for enrollment.
- One-time \$20.00 enrollment fee.
- Official high school transcripts with graduation date or official GED scores.
- College transcripts (if applicable).
- An immunization record, completed by a health care professional.
- Lawful Presence.
- DD 214 (if applicable).
- AccuPlacer and/or COMPASS Test scores.*

* AccuPlacer and/or COMPASS Test: The AccuPlacer Test and/or the COMPASS test can be exempted if the following requirements are met: SAT scores of 430 English, 400 math (Old SAT), Reading 24 and Math 22 (New SAT), or ACT scores of 17 English, 17 math. The AccuPlacer Test and/or the COMPASS test is used for entrance and placement purposes to determine whether learning support classes are needed.

The Compass Test is no longer being offered; however, we will continue to accept Compass Scores. The new placement exam is AccuPlacer.
