Special Notes*			
*Completion of all general education courses is strongly advised before enrolling in Nursing 1104.			
*Students need to review and be familiar with the admission requirements for the nursing program.			
*Application for the nursing program opens annually on October 1st.			
*Students must achieve a minimum grade of "C" in all core courses applicable to the nursing program.			
*Students must have a minimum of 2.50 GPA to qualify for admission to the nursing program.			
*Students must complete 27 semester hours of SGSC's SON general education requirements before enrolling in Nursing 1104. The 27 hours must include BIOL 2210K, BIOL 2211K, and PSYC 1101.			
*LPN-RN Bridge students must complete PSYC 2103 and BIOL 2215K prior to progressing to second level nursing courses			
* A student who makes less than a C in more than one required science course (Anatomy & Physiology I & II, and Microbiology), including a repeated course, will not be eligible for admission to, or progression in, the nursing program.			
*Students must complete the SGSC version of the HESI A2 Admission Assessment Test including the Critical Thinking portion through Evolve at Prometric Testing sites for admission consideration. Scores are valid only during the yearly application cycle beginning October 1st of each year. Only two attempts per year are allowed. The minimum accepted score is 75 on all sections.			
*Students must be licensed as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) in the state of Georgia with no current public or private disciplinary action by the first day of enrollment in the nursing course (NURS 1104).			
* Apply for Spring graduation one semester prior to graduation.
