This transfer program permits students to complete the first two years of preparation leading to teacher certification in early childhood education, middle grades education, secondary education, special education, speech-language pathology education, or health and physical education. Subsequent admission to a teacher education program at a senior college or university in the University System of Georgia requires a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 & passing the Reading, Writing, & Mathematics portions of the GACE basic skills assessment test. Academic advisement for the program is provided by the School of Arts & Professional Studies.
