The student must maintain a current, valid and unrestricted Registered Nurse (RN) license throughout the nursing program. For acceptance consideration into the RN to BSN Program, the student can only have 3 or less core classes remaining prior to beginning the program. Application for the nursing program opens annually on October 1st. Students must have a minimum of 2.50 GPA to qualify for admission into the nursing program. A grade of “C” or better is required for all general education core courses and Nursing courses to count towards degree completion. Note: NURS * = USG RN to BSN shared collaborative course delivered through eMajor in 8-week sessions.
